



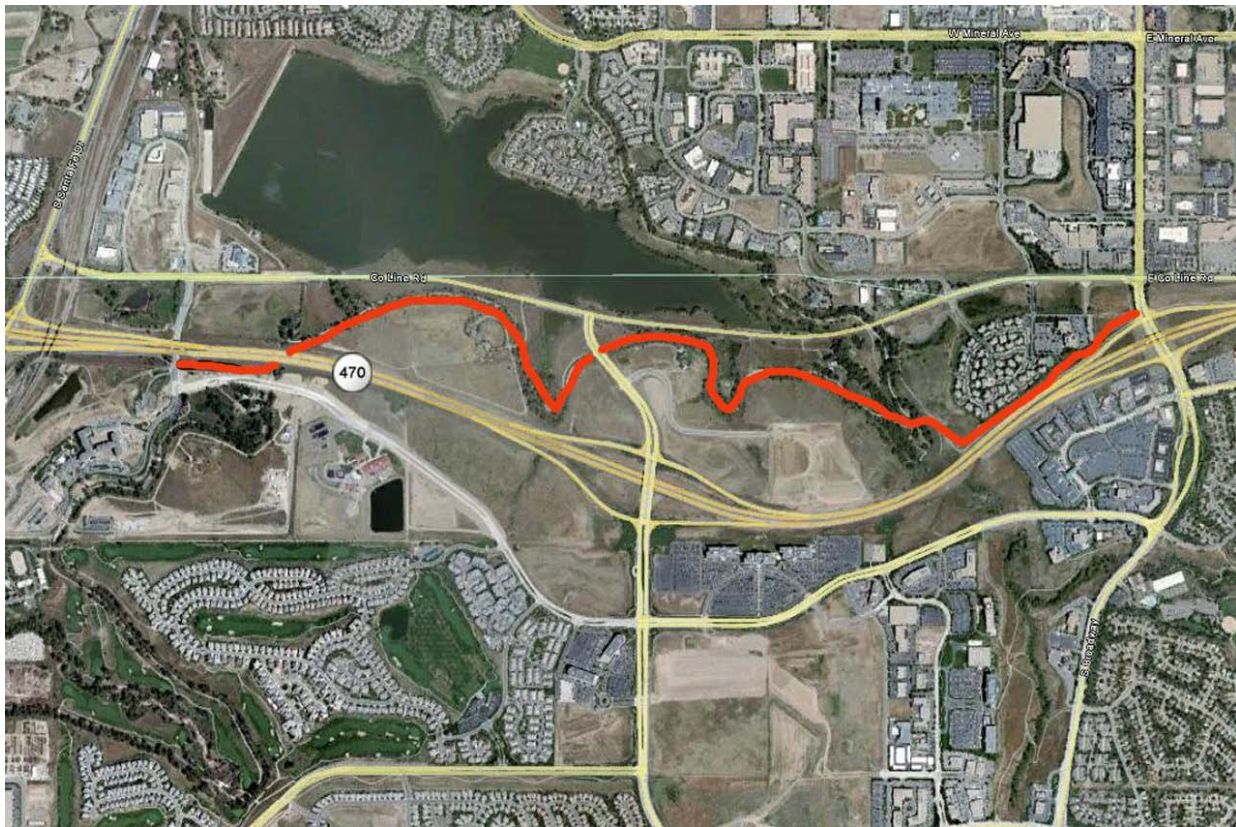
Centennial Trail Repairs

A portion of the Centennial Trail along the High Line Canal will undergo construction beginning Monday, Feb. 22. The Colorado Department of Transportation is removing damaged concrete trail and replacing it with new panels. The trail will remain open during construction however trail users will be directed to dismount from their bicycle. Flaggers will direct trail users through the construction area.

CDOT will work east to west beginning at the High Line Canal Trailhead on County Line Road near the intersection of County Line and Broadway. CDOT crews will make their way west to Erickson Blvd. Work is expected to be complete by Monday, March 22. The trail repairs are being funded through the American Recovery & Reinvestment Act.
