Candidates Sought For an Appointment to Metro District Board of Directors

Individuals who are interested in being considered for appointment to the Highlands Ranch Metro District Board of Directors must submit a letter of interest by 5 p.m. Thursday, June 22. The letter may be dropped off at the Metro District office, 62 Plaza Drive on the southwest corner of Broadway and Plaza Drive, or sent to Terry Nolan, Highlands Ranch Metro District, 62 Plaza Drive, Highlands Ranch, 80129 or tnolan@highlandsranch.org.

Candidates must be registered to vote in the state of Colorado and must live in, or own property in the west central region of the Highlands Ranch Metro District. For a region map, please visit www.highlandsranch.org and look to the Government section tab at the top of the screen, then select the Board of Directors link, or stop by the Metro District office. The Metro District Board will appoint someone to fill the seat vacated by Rick Owens, who recently resigned. The newly appointed director will serve the remainder of the term until May 2018.

Rick Owens has served as a Metro District Board Member for 15 years including several years as chairman. His leadership was instrumental in many accomplishments during his tenure including consolidation of four districts into one which saved money and lowered taxes, the construction of several parks, construction of the infrastructure that allowed the community to grow, the initiation of the parkway fence replacement program, renovation and opening/operation of the Highlands Ranch Mansion, significant growth in outdoor recreation programs and the Metro District's strong financial condition.
