

## Portion of Redstone Skate Park closes for renovation

The street skate area of Redstone Skate Park, 3280 Redstone Park Circle, will be closed for renovation from May 31 to July 14. During this time, the bowl areas and snake run will remain open. Users may also visit Tanks Skate Park, 10371 S. Broadway, during construction.

The goal of the renovation is to create a more durable and innovative design that appeals to skateboarders and riders at a variety of levels. The east side of the park currently has concrete quarter pipes along the perimeter and three ramp boxes. The new design will replace the three ramp boxes with a large concrete street skate plaza. A public meeting was held at the skate park in April and attendees provided input about the design.

Originally built in 2001, Redstone Skate Park is a 22,000-square-foot fenced concrete facility that is a popular destination throughout the year.
