Metro District conducting senior feasibility study

Residents are invited to a community open house Aug. 15 as part of the Highlands Ranch Metro District's Senior Adult Feasibility Study. The open house will be held at the Metro District's Hendrick Office Building from 4-7 p.m. Tuesday, Aug. 15.

Community members are encouraged to come, visit with staff and provide input on future services and programs to serve the adult population in Highlands Ranch. "We want to find out what the community feels are gaps or needs in services to the senior population," said Carolyn Peters, Metro District recreation manager. "We want to find out what their priorities for services, programs and facilities might be."

The Metro District Board of Directors approved the Senior Adult Feasibility Study in April. The process has involved taking an inventory of current programs and services, interviews with stakeholders, identifying program goals and partnership opportunities, and seeking input from the community to hear their needs and wants.

The community open house will be held at the Hendrick Office Building, 62 Plaza Dr., Highlands Ranch. Older adults as well as adult children of senior adults are encouraged to attend. For more information, contact Carolyn Peters at 303-791-2710.
