Students invited to participate in Veterans Day poster contest

Kids are encouraged to show their appreciation for our nation's veterans by designing an original piece of art.

Posters will be judged in three categories. They include:

- Grades 1-3

All posters submitted will be featured in a photo gallery on the Highlands Ranch Metro District Facebook page. The top three finalists in each category will have their poster displayed at the James H. LaRue Library. The winner in each category will be recognized during the Highlands Ranch Veterans Day event on Nov. 11 and will be presented with a prize.

The Highlands Ranch Veterans Day Celebration will be held Nov. 11 at 6:30 p.m. at the James H. LaRue Library in Highlands Ranch. The evening will feature a color guard from the Highlands Ranch American Legion, patriotic music from the Highlands Ranch Concert Band, and a keynote speaker.
