**Nomination forms due March 2
for Metro District director election**

People interested in running for a director seat on the Highlands Ranch Metro District Board of Directors must submit a self-nomination and acceptance form by 5 p.m. on Friday, March 2. Forms must be submitted at the Metro District office, 62 Plaza Drive on the southwest corner of Broadway and Plaza Drive. Forms are available at the Metro District office Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. until 5 p.m., or at www.highlandsranch.org.

Four seats are open, all for four-year terms, in each of the following Metro District regions: Northwest, South Central, Southeast and West Central. To view a map outlining these regions, please visit www.highlandsranch.org, select Government, then Board of Directors.
