



## POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT

### Park Ranger I

Highlands Ranch Metro District is currently seeking an experienced, motivated individual to fill a Park Ranger position in the Parks, Recreation and Open Space department. Successful candidate must be a team player and have a strong desire to provide excellent service to our community.

This is a full-time position working 40 hours per week, which requires working a flexible schedule including weekends, holidays, and evenings.

-March through November: Thursday-Monday, afternoon to late evening shift

-Off season: Monday-Friday (rotate weekends) morning to late afternoon shift

Duties and responsibilities include:

The primary duties of this position (March- November) will be to monitor and oversee reservations and recreational activities in all the Highlands Ranch Metro District parks. This position will also be assigned to patrol parks, trails and open space and interface with park users and program participants for oversight of rule compliance. This position will receive a limited commission as a Code Enforcement Officer through the Douglas County Sheriff's Office, and gain wildland fire training through South Metro Fire and Rescue.

This position will assist ranger staff during the off-season in the promotion of environmental stewardship to adult and youth groups at special events, schools and in parks and open space.

Applicants must have an Associate's degree in Parks, Recreation or Open Space management or related field, two years Park Ranger enforcement experience and the ability to present outdoor education programs. Combination of education and experience will be considered. Pre-employment drug screening and background checks, including driving record, will be conducted.
