

Water Well Near Paintbrush Park to Receive Maintenance

An underground water well near Paintbrush Park, on the corner of McArthur Ranch Road and Valleybrook Drive in Highlands Ranch, will be inspected and cleaned from approximately April 9 through May 18. This well maintenance work will take place from approximately 8 a.m. until 6 p.m.

Work at the site will include:

1. Mobilize equipment at the site
2. Remove and inspect the existing pump
3. Perform video and other tests in the well
4. Clean and disinfect the well
5. Demobilize at the well site

As the wells serving Highlands Ranch age, they can become less efficient and need to be cleaned periodically. Buildup of minerals in the well need to be removed and the well needs to be thoroughly inspected. This cleaning process involves removing and inspecting the well pump and motor, inspecting and cleaning the well, and reinstalling and testing all parts to ensure they are working properly.

Centennial Water and Sanitation District staff measures the efficiency of the wells before and after cleaning to determine the improvement of the well capacity and to ensure the effectiveness of the cleaning process. This effort extends the life of the wells and ensures efficient operations.
