

Foothills Park playground closed for renovation

The playground at Foothills Park will be closed for demolition and replacement beginning Monday, Nov. 5. Construction is expected to be completed by the end of the year, weather permitting. New playground equipment will be installed to provide a physically challenging and mentally stimulating inclusive play space that promotes social interaction.

Metro District staff held an on-site meeting with users on Aug. 22 to answer questions about the project and solicit input. Based on feedback, some of the new features of the playground will include:

- Swings, including a Konnection swing that allows adults and kids to swing at the same time
- Slides
- Sensory panels
- Climbing elements, including a standalone rotating net climber
- Sand and water play

The current wooden playground equipment was installed when the park was built in 2002, and has sustained significant wear and tear during the last 16 years. Foothills Park is located at 1042 Riddlewood Road, in Highlands Ranch.
