



Recreational Uses	.5 spaces per person based on occupancy, plus 1

Office Uses	1 space per 300 square feet of floor area, plus 1 space	
Office Uses	for each company-related vehicle




PARKING DEMAND PROJECTIONS



Mode Split



Parking Spaces for Special Events




Parking Spaces for Douglas County




Parking Spaces Needed to Support Project


