Saturday, Feb. 24 - Tuesday, April 16

All program registrations are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis or until leagues are full. Waitlists will apply once leagues are full or after the registration deadline.

Late fees - After the deadline, a \$15 late fee will apply and registrations will be placed on a waitlist. "Free agent" players who register by the deadline will be placed on teams before waitlisted players.

Team registration - Coaches must submit a team roster form to the Metro District prior to players registering for their specific team. If you have questions about how to submit your roster, please contact 303-791-2710 or recreationinfo@highlandsranch.org. The Metro District reserves the right to fill out each team's roster up to the maximum number allowed per league (13 for baseball & softball; 10 for T-ball). Teams are not allowed to exceed the maximum number allowed without approval from the Metro District league coordinator.

For all skill levels - The Metro District's goal is to allow every child the opportunity to compete on a team within a fair and competitively balanced league. With this goal in mind, parents/guardians are asked to rate their child's ability at time of registration. This will help create teams as equally as possible.
