

## Disc golf course proposed

The Highlands Ranch Metro District, in partnership with South Suburban Parks and Recreation District, proposes to construct a new 18-hole disc golf course and asphalt parking lot.

The proposed 60-acre West Fork Disc Golf Course would be added to land that is currently open space and trails. The open space trails would remain open to all users. West Fork Open Space is located from Plaza Drive to Highlands Ranch Parkway west of Broadway.



The proposed West Fork Disc Golf Course will be open to the public, and will enhance the recreational opportunities in the Highlands Ranch community. During the Metro District's 2009 community survey, the majority of residents supported a disc golf facility. The sport's popularity has grown and players have expressed the desire for a professionally designed course.

The course would be designed by a Professional Disc Golf Association – Disc Golf Course Designer. SSPRD would like to partner on the new course. SSPRD is removing their 18-hole disc golf course at David A. Lorenz Regional Park to construct a recreation complex.

During the Metro District Board of Directors meeting March 26, board members approved funding for a conceptual design of a parking lot accessed off of Broadway. Metro District staff members are contacting adjacent property owners to collect feedback on the proposed project.
