

Redstone Skate Park to close for construction

Redstone Skate Park will close April 15 to May 3 for construction. During this time, Tanks Skate Park, 10371 S. Broadway, will be open.

Improvements to the skate park will include:

- a. Making the small bowl continuous by removing the concrete entrance ramp. This change has been frequently requested by users.
- b. Removal of the planting beds and landscaping. Leaves, mulch and twigs continually contaminate the skating area and create safety hazards.
- c. Extending the quarter pipe on the east end of the street skate portion. This will improve the flow of the area.



The areas of Redstone Skate Park that will be improved are outlined in orange. During construction, the entire skate park will be closed.

The Metro District tries to plan closures and construction projects during times of low use, however concrete work must be done when temperatures are warmer.

Redstone Skate Park was originally built in 2001 and was renovated in 2017. The 22,000-square-foot fenced concrete facility is a popular destination throughout the year, and is located at 3280 Redstone Park Circle.
