Special Presentations

South Metro Fire Rescue's Chief Mike Dell'Orfano presented a quarterly update. Topics covered were:

- Response times continue to improve largely due to eliminating jurisdictional borders so the closest unit can be dispatched. (*Addendum 1*)
- Particularly high number of calls for Windcrest due to population demographics and density. SMFR is implementing risk reduction training programs such as cooking safety, prevention of fires and injuries, evacuation training, etc.
- Architectural plans for Station 20 have been finalized and plans have been submitted to Douglas County. Construction may begin in October/November.

- Their webpage has been redesigned.
- SMFR is in the process of re-districting as a result of the elections.
- Current operations chief Troy Jackson stepped down to focus on his health issues. The new operations chief is John Adams.
- SMFR is implementing additional programs to improve firefighters' health and wellness
- Safety Tip The smallest spark can cause disaster. Use caution, especially in the open spaces.
