

West Fork Disc Golf Course

The Highlands Ranch Metro District, in partnership with South Suburban Parks and Recreation, will construct a new 18-hole disc golf course, 50-space parking lot, and vault restroom at 9095 S. Broadway in the spring of 2020.

The future 60-acre West Fork Disc Golf Course will be added to land that is currently open space and trails. The open space trails will remain open to all users.



West Fork Open Space is located between Plaza Drive and Highlands Ranch Parkway west of South Broadway. It is ideal because of its size, the minimal impact on surrounding properties and its location — connected to the Metro District's extensive trail system, proximity to shops and restaurants, and convenient access from C-470.

The course will be available for free, drop-in use and the layout will be developed by a senior designer with Disc Golf Course Designers. Construction of the parking lot will begin in December. Construction of the course is expected to begin in February and is anticipated to be completed in May.

South Suburban Parks and Recreation, which removed its disc golf course at David A. Lorenz Regional Park earlier this year to build recreation complex, is partnering with the Metro District on this project. They will contribute \$160,000. The estimated project cost is \$480,000.

The object of disc golf is similar to golf — to make it from the tee to the hole in as few attempts as possible. Instead of swinging a club at a ball, participants throw a flying disc towards an elevated metal basket.
