

Metro District public meetings to be held through Zoom meeting format

In order to keep our community safe and healthy, and due to the stay-at-home order instituted to respond to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Highlands Ranch Metro District study session and board meeting will be held through Zoom meetings. Board members, staff and members of the public will all participate through Zoom.

To access a Zoom meeting, you will need to download the Zoom app (Zoom Client for Meetings). This can be downloaded at <https://zoom.us/download>.

Zoom can be used on a computer, smartphone or tablet. If your device does not have speakers/audio capability, a phone number will be provided upon login to give the option to call in and hear the meeting.

Members of the public attending board meetings via Zoom will be able to see meeting information including agendas, presentations and exhibits, and will be able to hear the discussions.

People who wish to make a comment or ask a question, will need to use the Q&A feature. Comments and questions received during the meeting will be read during the public comments section.
