

West Fork Disc Golf Course

Course design is complete for the West Fork Disc Golf Course, 9095 S. Broadway, and the public comment period has ended. The Highlands Ranch Metro District is constructing the new 18-hole disc golf course and 52-space parking lot with funding partner South Suburban Park and Recreation District.

Next steps include parking lot, restroom and course construction. While originally anticipated in late May, the opening of the course has been pushed back due to COVID-19, weather and construction delays. The expected opening date for the course is now anticipated in August.

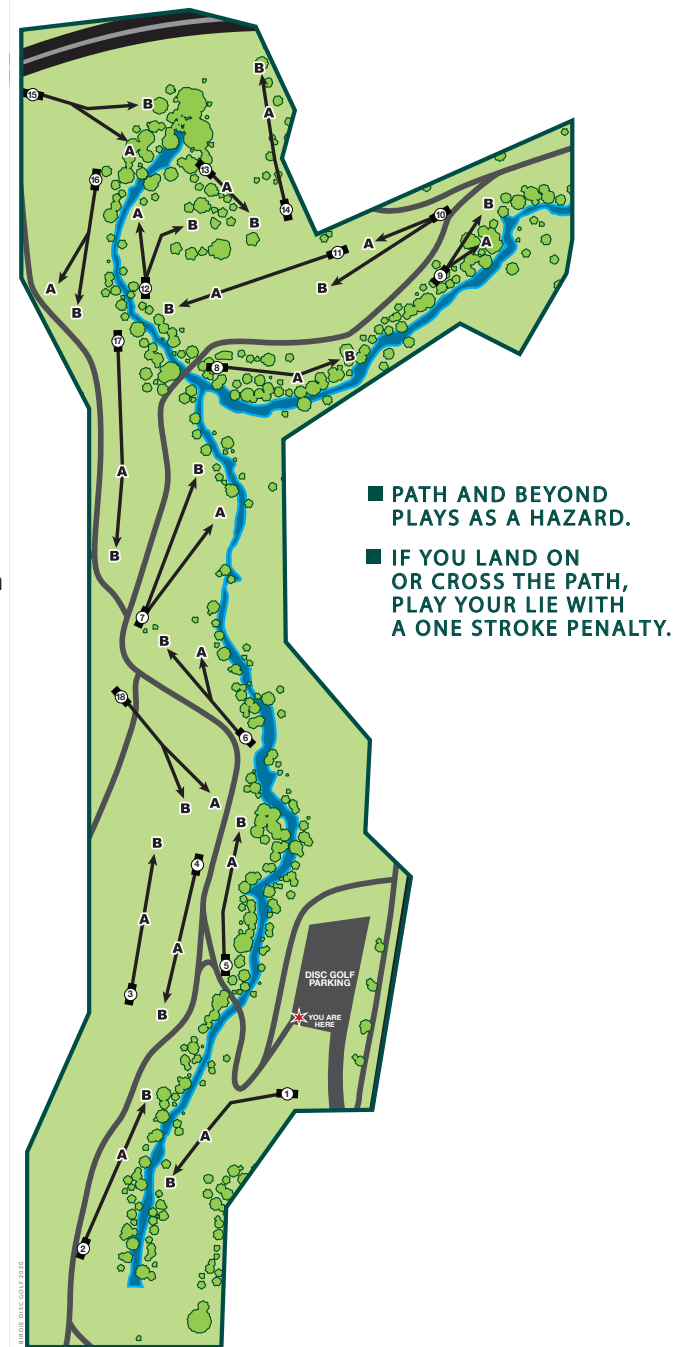
Important parameters during the design process for the 60-acre site included:

- topography
- impact to neighboring property owners
- natural resource protection
- wildlife protection
- existing trails
- underground utilities
- stormwater structures

The course was designed by John Bird, master course designer with Birdie Disc Golf LLC. Bird has designed or redesigned more than 18 courses across Colorado.

Once open, the disc golf course will be available for free, drop-in use. Organized use, such as tournaments and tag (ladder) play, will require a permit through the Metro District. Prior to opening, disc golfers are not permitted on the construction site of the future course. Users must remain on the trails during construction. These trails will remain open during and after construction to all users.
